



## LGBTQ+ Grievances Against the US Federal Government

Trump and his minions are symptoms of much greater hate and oppression that has been brewing in the US. His actions and values contradict with the values of New England as a region. We in the New England Independence Campaign, a queer- and ally-led separatist organization, envision a future where everyone in New England can live free from oppression with their rights protected.

We in New England can separate ourselves from the US regime and put an end to the following outrages being perpetrated throughout the country:

- Queer identity and any identity that's not white-straight-male is being erased from historical sites and government platforms/websites
- Health providers can lose their license for providing gender affirming care
- Health providers and places of employment can discriminate against queer people
- The Trump administration is destroying documents/passports/real IDs and birth certificates from trans individuals seeking to change their gender marker, renew their documents, or change their name
- If you try to leave the country with pro-LGBTQ media on your personal devices, or with documents that identify you as trans (gender markers not matching physical appearance or birth documents), ICE can either deny you the right to leave or they can detain you
- Police are permitted to disrupt queer rallies/events and detain people attending
- Homeland security are treating LGBTQ+ folk as threats to US security and are actively targeting LGBTQ+ folk
